Wow! What a first half term we have had! I hope you have had a lovely, restful half term and you are ready for another 7 weeks of jam-packed learning! This half term, we begin with an amazing trip to the Living Rainforest to kickstart our topic over the next 7 weeks - The Rainforest. In English we are creating work using our text, The Vanishing Rainforest whilst in geography, we are looking at Biomes. If the rainforest doesn't take your fancy, how about 'Making New Substances' in Science or Online Safety in computing. On top of all our new units, we also have the very busy Christmas period so make sure you check the dates below to ensure you don't miss out on anything!

School Timings

Physical Education and Games

P.E. will be on **Wednesday** and **Friday** for this half-term. P.E kits should be brought in on a **Monday** and will be sent home on **Friday** to be washed.

As the weather is becoming colder, tracksuits bottoms and your child's school jumper are suitable for outdoor games. Appropriate footwear is essential. Please make sure children do not wear jewellery to school on these days and that they have a hair band/bobble to tie their hair back, for health and safety purposes.



Home Learning

We have reviewed our homework provision across the Federation. Whilst homework can be an important tool in helping children with their learning, we realise that it needs to be purposeful and engaging. Therefore, we have made revisions to the homework that will be set going forward.

Reading: 3x weekly (minimum) - recorded in reading records (see below for more details).

Spellings: learn 5 spelling words. These will be set by the teacher on Mondays and weekly tests on Fridays to check and address gaps.

Maths: Times Tables Rockstars - 'little and often' throughout the week (roughly 10 minutes per day), aim for an hour over the week.

Reading



Regular reading will support your child in all areas of their learning. In Year 5, we want to inspire a love and enjoyment of reading. Their book should encourage them to ask questions, wonder and express opinions as well as expanding their vocabulary and knowledge. Children must be reading at least **three** times a week for **20 minutes**, which needs to be recorded in their reading record alongside an adult

comment or signature. Reading records will be collected **every Friday** to check if they are able to move up our reading challenge wall!
